

Claudio M. Radaelli (Milan, 1960) is Professor of political science (Anniversary Chair in Politics) at the University of Exeter , Department of Politics. He directs the Centre for European Governance, a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence (<http://centres.exeter.ac.uk/ceg/>), and is Jean Monnet chair in European Union policy analysis. He is the editor of the *European Journal of Political Research*.

A graduate in economics (Bocconi, Milan) Claudio worked in the private sector for seven years before starting his doctorate in political science at Florence in 1992. He was appointed lecturer at Bradford in 1995, before moving to Exeter in 2004.

Claudio has been visiting professor at the Universities of Warwick, Bradford, Sciences-Po in Paris, Milan and the European University Institute, Florence. He organized and directed three editions of the executive program on impact assessment for the directors of better regulation of the European Union in 2006 and 2007. His books include *Regulatory Quality in Europe* (Manchester University Press, co-authored with Fabrizio De Francesco), *Discourse and Policy Change in Europe* (Frank Cass, 2005, co-edited with Vivien Schmidt), *The Politics of Europeanization* (Oxford, 2003, co-edited with Kevin Featherstone), *Technocracy in the European Union* (Longman, 1999) and *The Politics of Corporate Taxation in the EU* (Routledge, 1997). He has published widely on regulatory impact assessment, regulatory indicators, Europeanization, policy learning, and international tax policy.
